Numeracy:

We will be working on fluency, word problems and reasoning focusing on gaps in learning throughout the year.

Art:

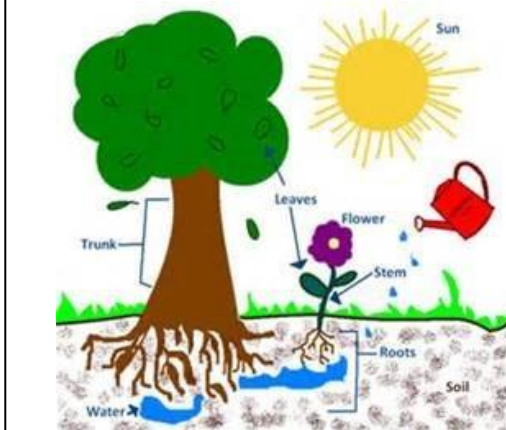
Children have been using a variety of mediums to create drawings and sketches of animals and plants. We will be using the nice weather to go outside and look at wildlife around the school grounds.

TOPIC - Living and Growing

This term's topic centres around Science



PSHE/Citizenship:

We will look at ways that we keep healthy. A particular focus will be what we do outside of school to eat healthy, exercise and to feel well.

Computing:

Children will be using Scratch as well as other programming software to create scenes and move objects around. They will also use 2Simple software to make their own games and comic strips.

English:

Poetry (2 weeks).

Information text (2 weeks)

P.E:

Pupils will carry out athletics activities in preparation for sports day. They will explore running, jumping and throwing activities and take part in simple challenges and competitions.

Science:
