



# Autumn 1 August-October    Year 2 Curriculum Map

## **Numeracy:**

### **Place Value (2 weeks)**

- Counting forwards, backwards and across 1-120
- Learning to count on from any given number
  - Partitioning of tens and ones
  - Writing 2/3 digit numbers in correct order e.g. 18 not 81.

### **Addition and subtraction (4 weeks)**

Using concrete equipment and visual representations:

- Number bonds to 10 and 20.
- Adding together 2, 2 digit numbers.
- Subtracting 1 digit and 2 digit numbers.
- Adding and subtracting multiples of 10 from any number.

## **PSHE/Citizenship:**

Exploring, identifying and managing feelings.  
Class discussions centred around sharing thoughts and experiences.

## **Art and D.T-**

Pupils will be focussing on sketching and drawing techniques.  
Outdoor flowers/trees  
Illustrating characters and settings linked to story  
Pupils will use wood land materials to make collage (red riding hood)

## **TOPIC -Story time**

Inspiration Day will have a focus on Goldilocks and the three bears. We will be printing with paint, making puppets and singing songs.

## **Science**

### **Animals and their habitats.**

Looking at the behaviours and adaptations animals make to suit their habitats.

### **Scientific Investigations**

Children will also be taking part in the planning and carrying out of investigations throughout the term. Making predictions and recording our findings.



## **Computing:**

Pupils will learn to log on to the computers using individual usernames and passwords.  
Basic mouse and keyboard skills.

## **English:**

### **Goldilocks (3 weeks)**

Retelling and rewriting of the traditional tale. Developing a newspaper report on Goldilocks' crimes. Character descriptions.

### **Non-fiction**

Pupils will be researching and reporting on animals featured in traditional tales (Brown Bears).

## **P.E:**

### **Basic Skills/Gymnastics**

Balancing  
Movement and levels  
Safe jumping  
Keeping safe using equipment.

## **Home learning:**

Pupils will have a maths and spelling/reading task. Reading at home is essential. Children should begin to read the clock to the closest 15minutes.
