

# Year 1 Autumn Term Curriculum Map



## MATHS

In Maths, the children will be learning about place value within 10. They will be counting objects and representing them using various manipulatives such as ten frames and counters. They will also be learning to recognise numbers as words and counting on from any number.

Key Vocabulary: sort, colour, size, shape, one more.

## HISTORY

Pupils will become curious about what toys from the past looked like, for example: doll houses, skipping ropes, blackboards, ride on toys and make comparisons with toys from today. They will know the different materials toys can be made from. **Key Vocabulary: last week, today, past, within living memory, Victorian period.** 

#### ENGLISH

This term, we will be reading Dogger, The Naughty Bus and The Three little pigs. In English we will re-tell and sequence stories, role play the stories we have read and also write a set of instructions.

Key Vocabulary: Narrative, beginning, middle, end, sequence, adjectives, instructions, finger space, full stop, capital letter.

## GEOGRAPHY

Pupils will be exploring their local area, studying aerial maps to identify features of Birstall. They will find features of the school grounds using a simple map.

Key Vocabulary: aerial view, map, houses, building, river, soil, road, park, river, lakes.

## SCIENCE

In Science, we will be exploring everyday materials. Children will be able to investigate the properties of different materials such as glass, metal, plastic and fabric. They will also be exploring why materials are used for certain objects, and not for others.

Key Vocabulary – glass, metal, fabric, plastic, hard, soft, transparent, waterproof.

## PE

In PE our unit is called 'Attack, defend and shoot' and we will know how to perform basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching. We will engage in competitive activities.

Key Vocabulary: Atack, catch, compete, defend



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## SMSC/RE/RHE

Pupils will understand that we all belong to someone such as parents, families. They will know that love is important in a lot of communities. Furthermore, pupils will know how love makes connections with others such as kindness and the 6Rs in school. **Key Vocabulary: Love, family, valuable,** 

Muslim, Christian, Jewish, belonging.

#### MUSIC

This term, we will be exploring the topic of 'how can we make friends when we sing together?'. Children will practice their singing whilst being introduced to the beat of each piece.

Key Vocabulary: beat, rhythm, together, patterns.

## ICT

Pupils will understand that technology is all around us and start to become familiar with the different components of a computer. Learners will also consider how to use technology responsibly.

Key Vocabulary: Technology, computer, mouse, keyboard, screen, click.

## Art and Design

This term, we will be exploring the primary and secondary colours. Children will look at the work of Paul Klee and Wassily Kandinsky, and create art in their style, using different prints, patterns, and the primary and secondary colours.

Key Vocabulary: primary, secondary, print, paint, pattern.
