

Year 2 Spring Term Curriculum Map

ENGLISH

In English this term, the children will be writing narratives using the book 'Somebody Swallowed Stanley' as well as writing fact files of Orangutans as well as David Attenborough.

Key Vocabulary: conjunctions, verbs, past tense.

MATHS

In Maths we will be focussing on multiplication and division using the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables.

We will also be looking at measure including cm and m.

Key Vocabulary: multiply, divide, cm, m, longer, shorter, pence and pound.

SCIENCE

The children will be looking at animals including humans and will be able to name the offspring and discuss the lifecycles of animals. They will also be looking at how we can keep ourselves healthy.

Key Vocabulary: mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians, fish, offspring.

HISTORY

Our theme this term is 'how people use their voices for change' and we will be looking at significant individuals such as Rosa Parks, Malala Yousafzai and Alice Hawkins.

Key Vocabulary: Society, cultural, suffragette, equality.

GEOGRAPHY

In Geography, we are looking at climate change and the effects. Focussing on deforestation and the polar ice caps.

Key Vocabulary: climate change, deforestation, ice caps, Amazon rainforest, carbon dioxide, impact.

PE

In PE we have been developing our skills with gymnastics and the different ways we can move and balance. We are also going to be developing our hit, catch and run skills.

Key Vocabulary: throw, hit, catch, balance

ICT

This term we will be looking at programming and the children will be learning how to program the beebots and debugging algorithms. They will also be learning how to input data.

Key Vocabulary: data, input, organise, instruction, algorithm, commands.

MUSIC

In music we are looking at rhythm and then they will be learning about pitch with short and long notes.

Key Vocabulary: pitch, rhythm, 8 bar score

SMSC/RE/RHE

In PSHE we are going to be looking at risks as well as the qualities needed for certain jobs.

In RE we are learning about the Easter story with the help from a local vicar.

Key Vocabulary: Risk, hazard, permission, Easter, holy, resurrection.
