

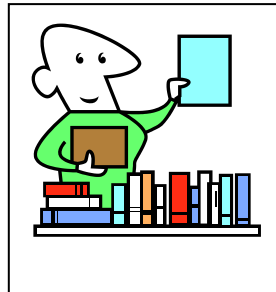
How many pages are there in the book?
