

Year 6 Summer Term Curriculum Map

MATHS

Children will continue to develop maths-based skills, involving number and problem solving. They will focus on the following units:

- Area, perimeter, volume
- Position & direction
- Statistics

ENGLISH

Children will be writing for a range of purposes and audiences, focusing on a selection of short extracts and animations to inspire and ignite their creativity. They will be looking specifically at narratives, explanation texts and biographies throughout the summer term.

SCIENCE

Light

Children will learn to explain Isaac Newton's 'Theory of Colour', understand how light is reflected and explore big questions such as what happens to light when it travels through different materials.

HISTORY

Following on from the Autumn Term, children will study what life was like following World War Two. They will create links between the end of WW2 and modern Britain and recognise the efforts of many citizens from across the Empire, including the effect of immigration on our local area.

GEOGRAPHY

Children will be learning about maps and their local area. They will learn to understand an OS map and how they are used to find specific locations. Additionally, they will study map symbols and be able to recognise these on a range of different map formats.

PE

In PE, children will be further developing their understanding of a variety of sports and physical activities. They will be looking specifically at athletics, invasion games and, striking and fielding.

ICT

This term in computing, children will be covering the following topics whilst deepening and securing their technology related skills:

- Creating media – 3D modelling
- Programming – sensing

MUSIC

This term in music, children will be covering the following topics whilst developing their musical knowledge and skills:

- How does music shape our way of life?
- How does music connect us with the environment?

SMSC/RE/RHE

In RE, children will be covering how faith helps people when life gets hard and, for Christians, what kind of God is Jesus?

In PSHE, we will be looking at relationships; what will change as we become more independent, and how friendships will change as we grow.
