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FS Summer Term Curriculum Map

PERSONAL, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

This term our PSED learning will focus on British Values. The children will learn about Democracy, The rule of law, Individual liberty, Respect and Tolerance.

Key Vocabulary: British Values, Democracy, Tolerance, the Rule of law, liberty, respect

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

This term our PE day is **Wednesday**! The children will be improving on their fundamental P.E skills such as throwing, catching, running, jumping and travelling.

Key Vocabulary: run, throw, jump, hop, catch, skip, circuits.

LITERACY, COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE

This term the pupils will be learning to write their own stories based on traditional tales. They will be building up their ability to plan, change and write their own version of the story through improving their sentence writing. The children will also be learning how to write instructions.

Key Vocabulary: story, write, plan, change, map, sentence, capital letter, full stop, finger space, instruction

MATHEMATICS

This term the pupils will be focusing on numbers beyond 10. They will practice their counting to help improve their knowledge of cardinality. They will be comparing numbers using the language of more than and less than. They will be learning about odd and even numbers, doubles and halves and also addition and subtraction.

Key Vocabulary: counting, cardinality, composition, comparison, more than, less than, number bonds, odd, even, double, half, addition, subtraction

EXPRESSIVE ARTS & DESIGN

This term, our expressive arts and design lessons will be focused on music and tempo and rhythm. We will take part in drama lessons based on the books we are learning in Literacy and through food technology we will be learning to recognise what makes for healthy food choices and then making our own 'Rainbow Salad'.

Key Vocabulary: speaking, listening, drama, healthy food, balanced diet, rhythm, tempo, pitch, loud and quiet.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

This term the children will be using their senses to explore the natural world around them during the season of Summer. We will be learning about animals and their life cycles and then comparing them to how humans change over time. The children will also have a go at growing different plants and vegetables from seeds and watch how they change.

Key Vocabulary: summer, season, animals, life cycles, butterfly, caterpillar, frog, tadpole, human, change, grow, plant, flower, vegetable, seed, soil, sun, water
