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PERSONAL, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

This term the pupils will be learning all about feelings. We will be using 'The colour monster' books to help us understand about the different emotions we may feel and how to deal with them.

Key Vocabulary: feelings, emotions, angry, cross, sad, mad, upset, happy, joyful, excited, worried, anxious, confused,

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

This term our PE day is Wednesday. We will be learning to balance, find space and move in different ways. We will start to recognise how physical activity affects our body and why it is good for us.

Key Vocabulary: balance, move, space, hop, skip, jump, travel, heart, beating

LITERACY, COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE

This term the pupils will be focusing on writing their name, using and applying their Phase 2 phonemes to read and write cvc words and simple phrases. We will also be learning to recognise rhyme and use this to write our own sill rhymes based on the books 'Oi Dog, Oi Frog' etc.

Key Vocabulary: rhyme, rhyming, rhyming pairs, phonemes, diagraphs.

MATHEMATICS

This term we will be learning to recognise numbers to 5. This will include subitising, counting, cardinality, composition and ordinality. We will be learning what makes 5 and the numbers up to 5. We will also be learning to recognise some 2D and 3D shapes and their features.

Key Vocabulary: number, order, counting, count, first, next, square, rectangle, triangle, circle, cube, cuboid, pyramid, sphere.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS & DESIGN

This term we will continue to embed our collage skills whilst linking it into our other learning. We will be learning to recognise primary paint colours and what happens to paint when we mix colours. We will also be learning to join materials and create a Christmas present by using our skills.

Key Vocabulary: collage, materials, scissors, paint, primary colours - red, yellow and blue.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

This term we will be learning about other people's cultures and communities by celebrating Diwali, Hanukkah and Christmas. We will be looking at where we live and recognise the features of where we live by drawing maps. We will also recognise the differences between hot countries and cold countries based on stories that we will read.

Key Vocabulary: maps, globe, Earth, England, Birstall, Africa. Antarctica. Diwali. Christmas. Hannukka
