### **Attendance Reminders**

Each week we promote and celebrate good attendance across the school. Research shows that poor attendance limits pupils' life chances, impacts on their academic success but more worryingly adversely affects children.

Can we remind parents that gates are open at 8.25am and all children are expected in class for 8.35am when the register is taken. Any absence from learning disrupts continuity of learning, undermines educational progress and should be avoided, therefore, holidays in term time will not be authorised.

<u>Exceptional Leave</u> - The school recognise that there may be times when a pupil requires exceptional leave during term time for short periods of time. In these circumstances parents are asked to complete the 'Exceptional Leave Form' to request the absence. These requests will be considered by the Headteacher on an individual basis.
