

FS Spring Term Curriculum Map

PERSONAL, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

This term the pupils will be learning all about right and wrong. They will learn about making good decisions and listen to a variety of books where the children can discuss if the actions are right or wrong.

Key Vocabulary: right, wrong, behaviour, decision, choices, good, bad

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

This term our PE day has moved to a **Wednesday**! Our focus in PE this term will be Gymnastics. The children will be learning different gymnastics shapes and positions and will develop these into jumps (e.g. star jump). The children will also be learning different types of rolls and balances. They will begin to combine all of these skills to create mini routines as well as exploring a range of apparatus.

Key Vocabulary: gymnastics, shapes, position, roll, jump, balance, tuck, pike, straddle, star, stretch

LITERACY, COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE

This term the pupils will be learning to write captions and simple sentences. They will learn how to use capital letters to begin sentences and full stops to end sentences. The children will be using their phonic knowledge to help them write words. They will also learn how to adapt and write their own story based on the story of the Three Little Pigs.

Key Vocabulary: words, letters, sounds, phoneme, grapheme, caption, sentence, capital letter, full stop, finger space, rhyme

MATHEMATICS

This term the pupils will be focusing our learning on the numbers up to 10, especially 6, 7, 8, 9, & 10. The children will learn about counting and cardinality, comparison, composition, addition, number bonds and subtraction up to 10. The children will also learn how to recognise 2D and 3D shapes.

Key Vocabulary: number, write, count, greater than, less than, equal to, sequence, order, add, plus, subtract, take away, number bonds, 2D shapes, 3D shapes.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS & DESIGN

The children will also take part in a number of musical lessons where they will explore body percussion, musical instruments and environmental sounds. We will also be using our joining skills to design and make a house.

Key Vocabulary: sound, music, body percussion, instrument, environmental sounds, split pins, cello tape, cutting, joining

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

This term the children will be exploring the season different season by using their senses. The children will also learn about Chinese New Year and make comparisons to the other festivals we have learnt about so far. They will be exploring how magnets work, floating and sinking and how things change through freezing, melting and heating.

Key Vocabulary: winter, spring, changes, floating, sinking, heating, cooling, freezing, magnetic, magnets.
