

Year 6 Spring Term Curriculum Map

SCIENCE

To understand the journey of blood around the body, what the key components of blood are, what is essential for living things survival and to understand that diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle have an impact on the way our body functions.

Key Vocabulary: nutrients, oxygen, function, circulatory, respiratory, skeletal, transportation, valve, pulmonary

MATHS

To develop knowledge of measures, geometry, statistics, algebra and incorporating a range of problem solving and reasoning opportunities with a mastery approach.

Key Vocabulary: formula, expression, equation, algebra, equivalent, input, output, conversion,

ENGLISH

To analyse the text 'Holes' by Louis Sahar where we have written from a range of perspectives, created our ending and produced non-chronological reports. We have also watched the BBC version of the Shakespearian Macbeth and looked at how playscripts are written.

Key Vocabulary: Texas, Yellow-Spotted Lizard, Juvenile, Warden, heath, Shakespearian, Prophecies.

HISTORY

To know the ways that crime and punishment have changed throughout British History and to understand how these choices have influenced our modern-day legal system.

Key Vocabulary: Roman Empire, crime, punishment, British, perspective, sources, period, historical figures.

GEOGRAPHY

To continue developing our knowledge surrounding what life is like in Brazil looking at human and physical features and demonstrating all this key knowledge in the form of an informative leaflet.

Key Vocabulary: location, trade, sustainability, environment, continent, South America.

PE
