

Year 2 Spring Term Curriculum Map



ENGLISH

In English this term, the children will be writing in a range of styles using different text as inspiration. Children will be writing letters, a speech and creating their own story.

Key Vocabulary: conjunctions, adjectives, verbs, past and present tense, contractions, apostrophes

HISTORY

Our theme this term is 'how people use their voices for change' and we will be looking at significant individuals such as Rosa Parks, Malala Yousafzai and Alice Hawkins.

Key Vocabulary: Society, cultural, suffragette, equality.

ICT

This term we will be looking at programming and the children will be learning how to program the beebots and debugging algorithms. The will also be learning how to input data.

Key Vocabulary: data, input, organise, instruction, algorithm, commands.

MATHS

In Maths we will be focussing on multiplication and division using the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables.

We will also be looking at measure including cm and m.

Key Vocabulary: multiply, divide, cm, m, longer, shorter, pence and pound.

GEOGRAPHY

In Geography, we are looking at climate change and the effects. Focussing on deforestation and the polar ice caps.

Key Vocabulary: climate change, deforestation, ice caps, Amazon rainforest, carbon dioxide, impact.

MUSIC

In music we are looking at rhythm and then they will be learning about pitch with short and long notes.

Key Vocabulary: pitch, rhythm, 8 bar score

SCIENCE

The children will be looking at animals including humans and will be able to name the offspring and discuss the lifecycles of animals. They will also be looking at plants and what they need to grow.

Key Vocabulary: mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians, fish, offspring, seed, flower, stem, leaf

PE

In PE we have been developing our skills in different sport by knowing how to effectively hit and catch a ball. Children will also be developing their coordination and endurance with Drumba.

Key Vocabulary: throw, hit, catch, balance

SMSC/RE/RHE

In PSHE we are going to be looking at risks as well as the qualities needed for certain jobs.

In RE we are learning about the Easter story with the help from a local vicar.

Key Vocabulary: Risk, hazard, permission, Easter, holy, resurrection.
