

# FS Autumn 2 Term Curriculum Map



## PERSONAL, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

This term the pupils will be learning all about feelings. We will be using 'The colour monster' books to help us understand about the different emotions we may feel and how to deal with them.

**Key Vocabulary:** feelings, emotions, angry, cross, sad, mad, upset, happy, joyful, excited, worried, anxious, confused,

#### PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

This term our PE day is still **FRIDAY!** Our focus in PE this term will be Dance. The children will be learning how to move their body in different ways, adapting existing dances and creating their own dances. The children will be learning about how to move their body in different dance styles, using emotions to change their way of moving.

**Key Vocabulary:** Dance, body movement, create, adapt, emotions, dance styles, ballet, hula, rock n roll

## LITERACY, COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE

This term the pupils will be continuing to develop their speaking and listening skills through activities to encourage speaking in full sentences, asking and answering questions.

The children will begin reading and writing CVC words in their phonics lessons, developing their letter formation.

The children will practice writing their name and start to have a go at writing short sentences, e.g. 'I am Polly'. **Key Vocabulary:** listen, full sentence, because, question, name. write. read. sentence. words

#### **MATHEMATICS**

This term the pupils will be focusing our learning on the numbers 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5. The children will learn about counting and cardinality, comparison, composition, addition, number bonds and subtraction up to 5. Towards the end of term, the children will also learn about 2D & 3D shapes, money and time (day and night).

**Key Vocabulary:** number, write, count, greater than, less than, equal to, sequence, order, add, plus, subtract, take away, number bonds, shapes, money, coins, buy, pay, time, night, day, sun, moon

### **EXPRESSIVE ARTS & DESIGN**

This term the pupils will be exploring and using a range of arty resources to create collages. Our collages will be based around autumn and a special Diwali themed collage to celebrate the festival of light.

The children will also explore the use of joining materials. For example, practicing scissor skills, using different types of glue, cello tape, paper clips, hole punch and split pins.

**Key Vocabulary**: collage, materials, resources, scissors, joining materials

#### UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

This term the children will be exploring the changes that happen during autumn through using their senses and making observations. They will learn about and compare the religious festivals Diwali, Christmas and Hanukah. The children will also be looking closely at their own lives and how they have changed over time, including their families, their toys and their clothes.

**Key Vocabulary:** seasons, autumn, senses, hear, see, smell, taste, feel, Diwali, Christmas, Hanukah, festival, similar, different, change, time, past, now, then
