

Year 6 Spring Term Curriculum Maps

MATHS

Children will continue to develop maths-based skills, involving number and problem solving. They will focus on the following units:

- Ratio
- Algebra
- Decimals
- Area, perimeter, volume
- Statistics
- Shape

ENGLISH

Children will be writing non-fiction texts based on their knowledge of South America. Children will write narrative texts based on a variety of stimulus including the Explorer by Katherine Rundell.

SCIENCE

Animals including Humans

Children will identify and name the main parts of the human circulatory system and describe the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood. They will also look at the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyles.

HISTORY

Throughout this term, children will study crime and punishment throughout time. By the end of the unit pupils will all know the timeline of British history and know how attitudes to crime and punishment have changed through history.

GEOGRAPHY

Children will be learning about the locations of South America and the countries which make up the continent. They will learn about geographical features, including the Amazon Rainforest and the layers within it. Human features linked to tourism will also be studied throughout the term.

PE

In PE, children will be further developing their understanding of a variety of sports and physical activities. They will be looking specifically at gymnastics and tennis.

ICT

This term in computing, children will be covering the following topics whilst deepening and securing their technology related skills:

- Variables in games - programming
- An introduction to spreadsheets – data and information

MUSIC

This term in music, children will be covering the following topics whilst developing their musical knowledge and skills:

- How does music improve our world?
- How does music teach us about community?

SMSC/RE/RHE

In PE, children will be covering why Hindus want to be good and what Christians believe Jesus did to save people.

In PSHE, we will be looking at how media can influence peoples. To support this, Children will be invited on a trip to the Warning Zone.
