

# FS Summer Term Curriculum Map



## PERSONAL, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

This term our PSED learning will focus on British Values. The children will learn about Democracy, The rule of law, Individual liberty, Respect and Tolerance.

**Key Vocabulary:** British Values, Democracy, Tolerance, the Rule of law, liberty, respect

## MATHEMATICS

This term the pupils will be focusing on numbers beyond 10. They will practice their counting to help improve their knowledge of cardinality. They will be comparing numbers using the language of more than and less than. They will be learning about odd and even numbers, doubles and halves and also addition and subtraction.

**Key Vocabulary:** counting, cardinality, composition, comparison, more than, less than, number bonds, odd, even, double, half, addition, subtraction

### PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

This term our PE day is **Thursday**! The children will be improving on their ball skills. They will be taking part in a number of activities to help them learn to roll, throw, catch, kick and dribble balls. These activities will help to improve their aim and co-ordination.

**Key Vocabulary:** ball, beanbag, hoop, cone, bench, roll, aim, catch, throw, kick, dribble, tap, between, goal, balance, equipment, obstacle, apparatus, racket,

#### **EXPRESSIVE ARTS & DESIGN**

This term, our expressive arts and design lessons will be focused on music. The children will be using technology to record their own sounds and voices as well as environmental sounds.

The children will also be learning how to read and use graphic symbol to help them remember sections of songs.

**Key Vocabulary**: technology, sound, voice, noise, record, song, sing, graphic symbols, section

### LITERACY, COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE

This term the pupils will be learning about the story 'The enormous turnip'. They will be building up their ability to plan, change and write their own version of the story through improving their sentence writing. The children will also be learning how to write instructions.

**Key Vocabulary:** story, write, plan, change, map, sentence, capital letter, full stop, finger space, instruction

#### UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

This term the children will be exploring the natural world around them now that we have entered spring. We will be learning about animals and their life cycles and then comparing them to how humans change over time. The children will also have a go at growing different plants and vegetables from seeds and watch how they change.

**Key Vocabulary:** spring, season, animals, life cycles, butterfly, caterpillar, frog, tadpole, human, change, grow, plant, flower, vegetable, seed, soil, sun, water
