

What do different animals eat?

1.	Herbivore 	Animals that only eat plants are herbivores.
2.	Carnivore 	Animals that mostly eat other animals (meat) are carnivores.
3.	Omnivore 	Animals that eat both plants and other animals are omnivores.
4.	Amphibian	Amphibians live in the water as babies and on land as they grow older. They have smooth, slimy skin.
5.	Birds	All birds have a beak, two legs, feathers and wings.
6.	Fish	Fish live and breathe under water. They have scaly skin, fins to help them swim and they breathe through gills.
7.	Reptiles	All reptiles breathe air. They have scales on their skin.
8.	Mammals	Mammals are animals that breathe air, grow hair or fur and feed on their mother's milk as a baby.
